# **DAY 2 MORNING/MIDDAY OFFICE**

## Silence and Stillness before God (1-2 minutes)

### **Scripture Reading**

Two people are better than one. When two people work together, they get more work done. If one person falls, the other person can reach out to help. But **those who are alone** when they fall **have no one** to help them. If two people sleep together, they will be warm. But **a person sleeping alone will not be warm**. An **enemy might be able to defeat one person**, but two people can stand back-to-back to defend each other. And three people are even stronger. They are like a rope that has three parts wrapped together—it is very hard to break. (Ecclesiastes 4:9-12, ERV)

### **Devotional**

In 1984, a goofy little movie with a catchy theme song became a Box Office hit! Both the movie and its theme song were an instant hit! The theme song is still popular on classic radio today. There is a phrase from that song that still sticks in the minds of many of you. It goes like this —

## Who you going to call? GHOSTBUSTERS!

When life is hard, **who you going to call**? When the ball of life doesn't bounce your way; when it rains on your parade; when the phone rings and it's bad news – whose number do you dial? Where can you go for comfort? Whose shoulder can you cry on? Who is that listening ear?
