

Summer 2020 Missions Trips Overview



Rochester, MN: July 19-24 (Current 6th and 7th graders)

Purpose:

The Rochester mission trip will provide our 6th and 7th graders with an opportunity to serve in the community and with the local church. We strongly believe that serving locally should serve as a foundation for serving regionally and internationally. This missions experience will give students new responsibilities and challenges within a more controlled environment, according to their abilities.

Nonrefundable Deposit: \$30
Cost for Students: \$150



Black Mesa, AZ: July 4-12 (Current 8th – 12th graders)

Purpose:

This regional trip will provide our high school students with the chance to live out their faith and be the hands and feet of Jesus by serving others. This trip will require more from the students and challenge them to own their faith. We strongly believe that having a cross-cultural experience in the U.S. prepares students to serve internationally.

Nonrefundable Deposit: \$50
Cost for Students: \$600



Belize: June 20-28 (Current 11th and 12th graders)

Purpose:

The Belize trip will give our 11th and 12th graders an amazing opportunity to experience and interact with the global Church outside of the United States. This trip will require students to show a good understanding and ownership of their personal Christian faith, flexibility in cultural differences and a willingness to serve in new situations.
