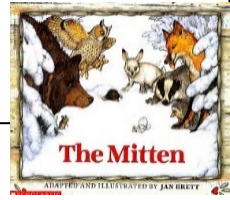
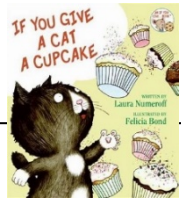
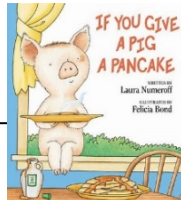
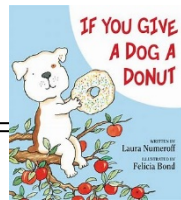
I hope you have had a wonderful start to the New Year. We will continue to need outside play clothes. Please keep sending a separate bag that is just for winter wear.

Just a reminder that Kingdom Kids teachers will ask for the ID of adults who are unknown or unrecognized by the teacher; when said adult is picking up your child from class or extra services. In Creative Adventures, we will be talking about stories and how to retell them. We will learn about starting with phrases like "One day" or "Once Upon a time". Then we move to "Something happened to fill in character name". In the middle of the story, we use sequence words like "First," "Next," "And then," and "Later." We finish the story with words like, "Finally," and "Last of all."
Kids can use this technique to retell stories from books they have read by putting it into their own words. This can also be a great way to pass the time while waiting for other things (like dinner to be done in the oven, a long car ride, a long line at the store, etc). It can be a fun way to make up stories together as a family.

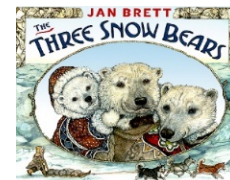
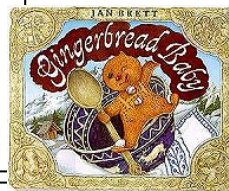
