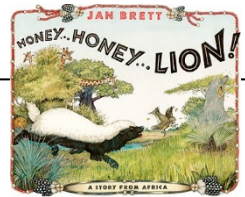
In class, we are working to show appreciation of one another's art work and one another's acting moves. We have been making excellent progress at supporting our friends with positive comments. We practice saying things to each other like "I like how you did that," "great dance moves," "awesome acting," "neat idea. We practice positive comments about each other's art work like: "tell me about that" (instead of 'what is it'), "nice art work," "I like this ___ about your work," etc... Please help continue practicing positive art appreciation comments at home.

In March, we will continue talking about stories and how to retell them. We have talked about starting with phrases like "One day" or "Once Upon a time". Then we move to "Something happened to fill in character name". In the middle of the story, we use sequence words like "First," "Next," "And then," and "Later." We finish the story with words like, "Finally," and "Last of all."

Themes This Month: We will continue acting out stories with props: using some of our favorite Jan Brett stories: We will be using them to learn how to tell stories

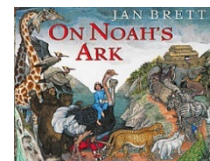
